SKILL OR LEADERSHIP AREA: _____ First Responder/CPR _____

TASKS TO BE PERFORMED:

1. Contestants will demonstrate their ability to perform procedures or take appropriate action based on scenarios presented related to the following topic areas:
 - a. CPR for the adult, child, infant
 - b. Choking victim (Chest compressions will be the only accepted procedure for unconscious choking)
 - c. Bleeding
 - d. Seizures/convulsions
 - e. Drowning
 - f. Burns
 - g. Head, neck and back injuries
 - h. Dislocations and broken bones
 - i. Eye injuries
 - j. Diabetic reactions
 - k. Sprains
 - l. Wound care
 - m. Heart attacks
2. All skills demonstrated will be based on nationally accepted standards as identified by the American Red Cross for first aid emergencies, the American Heart Association for CPR, the National Safety Council and Medical First Responder texts.
3. CPR will be judged based on 2010 ECC standard.
4. Contestants will be required to present certification credentials from a nationally recognized source in CPR.
5. The written test will be made up of questions from the American Red Cross, American Heart Association and Medical First Responder texts.

STUDENT MUST SUPPLY:

- Airway barrier device appropriate for CPR
- Surgical gloves
- Resume – 1 page
- #2 pencil

TECHNICAL COMMITTEE WILL SUPPLY:

- Mannequin(s)

- AED Trainer(s)
- Any other materials necessary to correctly complete tasks.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENT (if different from National contest):

- SkillsUSA work shirt, plain white shirt or plain white polo shirt
- Dark pants
- Appropriate shoes
- No school logo, name or identifying marks of any kind.
