TASKS TO BE PERFORMED:

- Written Test
- Soldering Test

STUDENT MUST SUPPLY:

- Wire strippers
- Multimeter
- Soldering iron
- Solder
- Needle nose pliers
- Nut driver or ratchet set
- Phillips and flat head screw drivers
- Safety glasses
- Pencil
- Note paper
- Calculator (any kind)
- Crimper (crimping tool)
- 1 page resume

TECHNICAL COMMITTEE WILL SUPPLY:

- Heat Guns
- Bones (dash board radio removal tool)

CLOTHING REQUIREMENT: Due to the professional nature of this contest, contestants are required to wear apparel appropriate to the trade.

- Leather work shoes are required - no athletic shoes allowed.
- Only shirts with a collar are acceptable, **NO TEE SHIRTS-no exception**. Shirts are to be tucked into trousers.
- Basic work-style jeans will be acceptable, however trousers are preferable.
- Any necklaces or bracelets must be removed and long hair is to be tied back.
